#### Overview of Southern Water

#### **Drinking Water**

- We supply 521 million litres of drinking water per day
- This requires nearly 14,000 km of water mains and 83 water treatment works
- 70% from underground (aquifers)
- 23% from rivers
- 7% from storage reservoirs

#### Wastewater

- We treat 718 million litres of waste water each day
- This requires 365 treatment works and almost 40,000km of sewers




## Southern Water supply area






## Southern Water and Catchment Management


- Shift in culture from engineered solutions to working in catchment
  - Proactive rather than reactive / prevention better than a cure
- Working with Catchment Sensitive Farming since 2016
- Engaging with existing partnerships and farm clusters
- Recruiting a Catchment Risk Management Team in 2018
- Currently completing investigations and piloting Catchment Schemes
- Full Catchment Management delivery from 2020

# Catchment Investigations Identifying fast pathways



#### Southern Water Catchment Schemes

- Metaldehyde substitution schemes
  - River Adur and Rother Valley
  - Eastern Rother
  - Medway
- ChaMP incentives for N reduction
  - Free SMN sampling
  - Payments for cover cropping
  - Precision farming
- A septic tank and oil tank replacement grant scheme (coming soon)
  - Up to £2,500 for oil tanks
  - Up to £5,000 for septic tanks and package treatment works
- Farm capital grant scheme



#### Farm Capital Grant Scheme

- Currently open in ChaMP area and the River Beult (Medway)
- Pesticides focussed but includes an option for 'other items'
- Up to £10,000 per farm per year
- Apply by 15<sup>th</sup> Feb 2019, claim by 28<sup>th</sup> Feb 2020
  - Bunded concrete pad £1,875
  - Biobed £3,375
  - Biofilter £1,485
  - Roofing up to 50% of costs
  - Other projects and innovative ideas as agreed
